Change in procedure for entry forms

Everyone will need to fill out the following **“Contestant Approval Form”** and submit it with or prior to our first entry form.

You will no longer have to get “EACH” entry form signed by the principle or notarized; however, you **MUST** take this form to your school and have it signed by your superintendent or principle. You will also need to take this form to have it notarized. This form will stand good for your seasons entry forms as long as this form is on file with the secretary. **Entry forms will not be accepted without it on file.** You, your parents or guardians will also have to sign before submitting to secretary.

PARENTS: You will need to check the “X” box for all events that you are allowing your contestant to compete in as well as initial and date this box. If contestant enters an event that has **NOT** been checked by parent approval the computer **WILL NOT** accept the entry. Therefore, if you are considering entering other events at a later date (such as cutting) then you need to check and approve those events as well.

We are hoping that this will be an easier system for you on entering our rodeos. It will take the hazzle out of taking your entry forms to school every time and trying to find a notary for each entry form.

This system should resolve any problems or issues on entering rodeos **on time**. Each entry form will still have separate due dates as before as of the postmark date.

INFORMATION & GROUND RULES:

YOU CAN MAIL MORE THAN ONE ENTRY FORM IN AT THE TIME AS WELL AS MAKE OUT ONE CHECK FOR ALL DUES, FEES OR ENTRY FORMS MAILED IN.
WILL NOT ACCEPT ENTRY FORMS WITHOUT PAYMENT!!

YOU WILL RECEIVE ALL OTHER FORMS, BACK #'S, RULE BOOK, DECALS, ETC. AT CHECK-IN OF YOUR FIRST RODEO

1. **POINTS: Are paid per rodeo as following**

1st place.....	10 Points
2nd place.....	9 points
3rd place.....	8 points
4th place.....	7 points
5th place.....	6 points
6th place.....	5 points
7th place.....	4 points
8th place.....	3 points
9th place.....	2 points
10th place.....	1 point

STATE FINALS RODEO will be worth **10 points more than total points possible at regional total points.**

2. **ALL-AROUND POINTS** to be awarded to top 6 places each rodeo, each event Entered, according to entries of that event. Must qualify in at least **TWO EVENTS IN ONE PERFORMANCE** rodeo to receive credit in the all-around standings.
3. **JACKPOT PAYOFF** each day of rodeo performance. Payoff up to six places, according to number of contestants per event.
4. **ENTRY FEES** for each regional, per rodeo, per event, per go-round is **\$30.00**, divided as following, \$10.00 jackpot, \$10.00 AJHRA general fund, \$10.00 host fee. There will be a **\$2.00** office charge/ **\$5.00** liability insurance fee added to each entry form per contestant. **Total for 1 event for both rodeos = \$67.00 per rodeo.**
5. **ENTRY FORMS** must be signed by parent/guardian, contestant. Forms are usually due into rodeo secretary approximately 3/4 weeks prior to rodeo. Each entry form has a different due date listed at top of form. Secretary has right to refuse form if post mark is after due date. **FEES MUST BE PAID WHEN MAILING IN FORM. NO REFUNDS AFTER THIS DATE.** There will be a **\$25.00 charge** for any returned checks or late fees. You will not be allowed to rodeo until all fees are paid. **Once contestant is entered in a rodeo you must have a medical or vet release in order to draw out of an event in order to be able to run another event for that performance.**

6. **CONTESTANT MEETINGS** - Will be notified on entry form. Following rodeo's you must check-in prior to books closing 30 minutes before starting rodeo time. If you fail to check-in prior to closing time - you will be considered as a **NO-SHOW**, unless you have a doctor's/vet release, can prove legitimate emergency reason for being late. You will sign in for check-in at each rodeo. **If you sign-in someone else that will be late and they do not show-up, neither contestant will be allowed to rodeo at the next rodeo.**
7. **AJHRA GROUND RULES:** Pole Pattern is broken when stirrup goes past pole. Barrel racers/pole benders - run must continue from point of broken pattern - **no starting over**. Calf roping/breakaway - **only one loop permitted**. Team roping - **2 loops only - 30 second time limit**. If you are entered in more than one event at a rodeo and do not compete in one event **but are still entered in another event, you can not compete in that event without doctor/vet release for that event.**
8. **TIMED EVENTS** when the electric eye fails to work for one or more contestants during a performance, the manual backup time will be used for those electronically missed. The electric eye controlled times will remain unaltered.
9. **BACK #'S:** Each contestant will be issued (2) back #'s for the year, each will have the same # on it. You will be responsible to have your number at each rodeo at check-in and in dress code. You will pick up back #'s, membership cards, and any other items at your first rodeo you attend. These will not be mailed to you. **There will be a \$2.00 laminating fee at check-in at first rodeo.**
10. **DRESS CODE** Pull over shirts of any kind are not allowable dress. This includes no 3 button pullovers. In case of incimate weather, you can wear pullover sweater, over long sleeve button-up collared shirt. If wearing coat during performance - back number must be pinned to back of coat - **VISIBLE. Hat – Long Sleeve Shirt, Boots, Jeans and BACK#.**
11. **INSURANCE CLAIMS:** If you are injured at our rodeo and taken to the hospital or doctor, you need your **NHSRA MEMBERSHIP CARD** with you for proof of insurance. Afterwards, the secretary will sign (1) insurance form for you to send to insurance company for proof of injury at that rodeo.

12. **AJHRA TEAM SHIRTS & T-Shirts:** Will be available for purchase. Must have payment in advance. Will deliver at the rodeo's.

RIBBON ROPERS & TEAM ROPERS: Anyone interested but does not have a partner, contact Anita to be put on the availability list. You can enter up to 4 single rodeos with a draw partner. Points are based on individual thru-out the year – you can change partners or change ends at any time. **ROPE ONE TIME PER RODEO**

RIBBON ROPING: Must be 1 boy, 1 girl combination, can change ends or partners at any time during the year (stated on your entry form)– pts. are based on individual. If you are in need of a partner – contact Anita for availability list.

BOYS –Tie Down/Breakaway Ropers – you can enter one or the other – **NOT BOTH!**

Home School Verification Form

Contestant Qualifications, pg 24, Rule #1

In accordance with the NHSRA rulebook pertaining to contestant qualifications, students who attend a homeschool, private school, religious school or correspondence school are eligible for membership if the school is recognized and approved by the state/province board of education or National Board of Education in the state/province the member is applying for membership. The contestant would need to show proof that the school they are attending is accredited and that they have met the grade requirements.

If the school the student is attending is not accredited by the State or National Board of Education the student shall demonstrate composite grade-level academic proficiency on any State Board or National Board of Education recognized achievement test or other mechanism as provided for in State or National Board of Education rules. A student shall be eligible if they achieve a minimum composite score or survey test score within the average or higher than average range as established by the test service utilized on any nationally-normed test.
