State Final's Information

ENTRIES:

1. *You must pre-enter for State Finals Rodeo.*
2. *All fees must be paid with entry form. - Entry Forms MUST be postmarked by due date – Friday, April 27 or turn in at Texarkana regional*
3. *You must have entered an event at previous regional rodeos to compete in that event at finals.*
4. *Please read Y-T-D point standing sheet – if you have a conflict in points – contact me immediately.*
5. *Ribbon Roping & Team Roping: partner you enter with will declare a team total going into the finals rodeo. This partner is who you will qualify as a team with for national finals rodeo.*

COGGINS PAPERS:

These will be checked when entering the fairgrounds – MUST HAVE ORIGINAL PAPER (NO COPIES)

STALL & RV FORMS:

*You are available to come in on **Friday** night as well as stay thru **Saturday** night!*

These are included in your packet – Stalls @ \$15.00 per horse per night, RV's @ \$20.00 per night – you must make reservation in advance. Send this in with entry form also.

CONTESTANT CHECK-IN:

***SATURDAY** morning with secretary – 10:00 am – MANDATORY IN DRESS CODE!*

Performances – Sat. - 12:00 Noon - Sunday 10:00 AM:

1. *Sat. - 1st go round at 12:00 noon – position will be drawn – new order of events.*
2. *Sunday - 2nd go round at 10:00AM – same order of events but will REVERSE position order.
Example - (If you were first in an event 1st round – will be last in event 2nd round)*

Points will be awarded in the Average at State Finals!

Breakaway & Calf Ropers

You will be allowed to carry (2) loops – 30 second time limit – 2nd loop must be tied on

You are not allowed to rebuild 1st loop!! Ribbon Roping – 1 loop

Team Ropers – 3 Loops Allowed – 30 second time limit

YOU MUST HAVE RECEIVED AT LEAST ONE (1) POINT IN AN EVENT TO QUALIFY!

STATE FINAL AWARDS:

We will be awarding Gist buckles to the top four & average contestants in each event. Also we will award saddles to all the Year End Event Winners.

ROLLDOWN: *We will be allowed to roll down places in each event if someone in the top 4 positions will not be going to the national finals. So if you are in the (5th – 8th) place and know you would like to go to the National finals – do not leave that night without verifying that all positions are filled.*

SIGN-UP IS ONLY AVAILABLE AT THIS TIME!! We will have a notary present to sign for all paperwork.

The Jr. Division National Finals Rodeo sign-up paperwork will be completed following the awards ceremony. THERE IS NO ENTRY FEE FOR THIS! You will need to know if you are camping or need a motel. A deposit will be required at signup for Camping fees of \$325.00. Stall fees will be \$159.00 for the week per horse, so you will need to know how many horses you will be taking. Both parent & contestant signatures will be required on entry forms.
